They were as far south and north as we could see. Looking up into the very blue sky at the geese we saw the white birds with black wing tips and also found a couple of Blue Geese in the group. The third sighting was at Eide Road where we saw both the black morph and the regular Rough-legged Hawk. The black morph was kiting over the fields and the sun was shining on him so that his coloring was spectacular. We also found our first swallow of the year.
