Later, along Boe Rd. some saw a Short-eared Owl and a Wilson's Snipe, and all got good looks at Western Meadowlarks and Snow Geese. On Thomle Rd., a rare Harris's Sparrow gave a great show. It was a life bird for several in the group. Other good sightings included Cooper's Hawk, Northern Harrier and American Kestrel.
